Abstract Submission Guidelines:

Presentation Length: 75 minutes

**Please note that all breakout sessions will occur on Tuesday, February 9th*

Abstract Format:

The abstract must be typed, single-spaced on 8.5" X 11" paper and submitted using minimal text formatting. The following information must be included on all submitted abstracts:

1. Title of abstract.
2. Presenter's name(s), presenter's credential(s) and organization name(s). Please also include an address, telephone number and email address for each presenter. Please indicate the primary presenter by underlining the name. All communication will go to the primary presenter, so please ensure they have a working email.
3. Short biographies on each presenter (NO MORE than 100 words per presenter please).
4. Type of Presentation: lecture, information sharing, interactive, workshop, panel, etc.
5. Target Audience(s): researchers, educators, caregivers, psychologists, physicians, etc.
6. Presentation theme. Please select the theme that best fits your presentation:
 - Assessment & Diagnosis
 - Education & Training
 - Innovative Practices
 - Community Capacity & Collaboration
 - Supports for Individuals & Caregivers
 - Awareness & Prevention
 - Research & Evaluation
7. Level of knowledge required about FASD to best benefit from the presentation: introductory, intermediate, or advanced.
8. A short (NO MORE than 150 words please) overview of the material covered by the presentation.
9. Any other recent conferences, if applicable, where this presentation has been made. If the presentation is new or updated material that has not been presented yet, please indicate this.
10. Equipment requirements (i.e. microphones, LCD projector, flipcharts, etc).

The deadline for submission of abstracts is October 1, 2009
