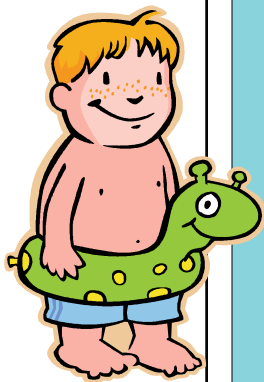

THE APPLICATION DEADLINE FOR ALL STUDENTS (NEW AND RETURNING) FOR THE 2011-2012 ACADEMIC YEAR (SEPTEMBER 2011-AUGUST 2012) IS

JUNE 1, 2011.

INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED AND WILL BE RETURNED TO THE STUDENT.

APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER JUNE 1, 2011 WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING.

IF YOUR APPLICATION IS RECEIVED AFTER THE APPLICATION DEADLINE IT WILL NOT BE PROCESSED AND YOU WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING FOR THE 2011-2012 ACADEMIC YEAR.

Think seasonal! Construction work or working in the seasonal sections of big box stores are perfect for students who just need May-August employment!
